Progress depends on....


- Natural talent / aptitude v effort
- Learning in TL country v learning in your own country

Hard work and the potential to influence their ability through practice and effort' (Mercer & Ryan, 2010: 437).

LESSONS TO BE LEARNED

- TL Contact = Increased proficiency
(Sundqvist, 2009)
- Start good habits young
 - TV Not dubbed
 - 70% English-language imports (Henry, 2014)

LESSONS TO BE LEARNED

- **Exploit interest**
 - 90% of boys 13-16 (Henry, 2014) play video games
 - *English mediated* video games
- **Practice: purposeful & interactive**
 - interaction with other players
 - reading in-game texts
 - engaging with game-related websites and communities
 - vocabulary learning strategies. (Chik, 2015)

OUTSIDE CLASS

- ‘motivational dissonance’ (Ushioda, 2013)
- ‘frustrated authenticity’ (Henry, 2014)
 - Ls suspicious of teacher ‘appropriation’ of their world (social media) for teaching purposes



